The Graduate School invites nominations for the Herbert F. Frolander Award for Outstanding Graduate Teaching Assistants. The intent of this award is to recognize outstanding teaching and professional involvement, with both faculty and students, by a domestic or international graduate teaching assistant at Oregon State University.

In the online application form, be prepared to provide the following information:

1. Is the nominee a graduate student in a graduate degree-seeking program at Oregon State University?
2. Does the nominee intend to enroll in at least 3 graduate credits during the fall 2022 term?
3. Has the nominee held a teaching assistantship for at least three terms within the preceding two years?
4. Is the nominee making satisfactory academic progress?
5. Has the nominee provided significant mentorship to undergraduate students in research-related endeavors at OSU within the past three years?

11. A completed Summary of Courses Taught form, including at least three terms of teaching within the preceding two years.
12. A completed Summary of Teaching Evaluation Scores form, including departmental median scores. In some cases, college median score.
