ASSISTANTSHIPS

- Hired by the university
- Tuition remission, health insurance, and a stipend
- Time commitment up to 19 hours a week
- Need to be enrolled in at least 12 credits/3 during summer

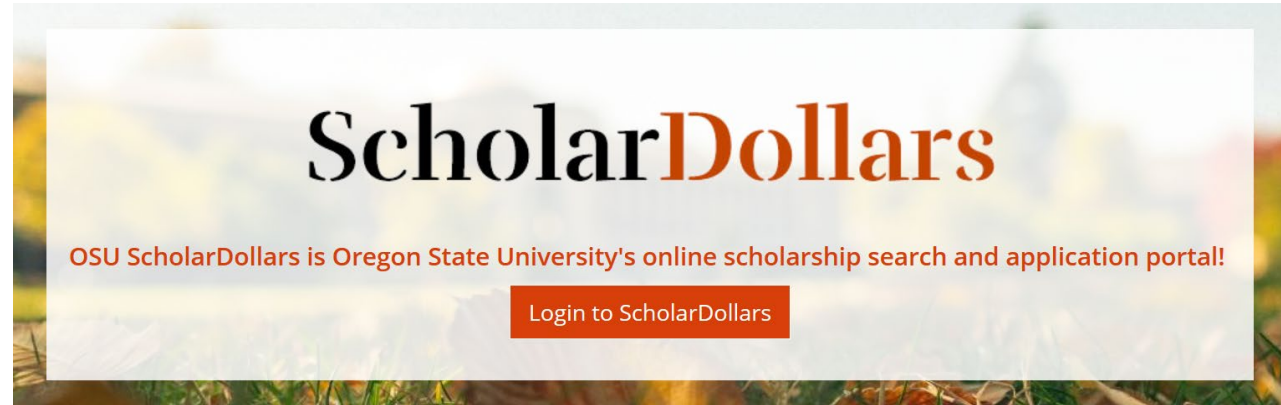
FELLOWSHIPS

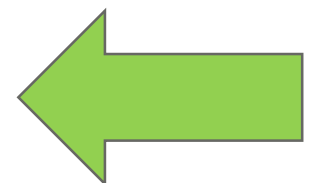
ON OR OFF-CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT

How Much is Tuition?



Tuition and mandatory fees are set by Oregon State each year based on residency status.

Graduate Assistantships



Graduate Assistantships are employment-based appointments where students, in exchange for their service, receive a stipend, tuition coverage (called remission), and an institutional contribution toward mandatory fees and a health insurance program only available to graduate assistants.

Fellowships and Scholarships



Fellowships and scholarships are an essential source of funding designed to help graduate students meet their educational and research expenses. Some fellowships and scholarships are awarded institutionally by the Graduate School or by academic college and department committees, while external agencies award others.

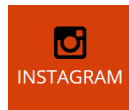
