Nomination Form Overview 2020-2021

The Graduate School invites nominations for the Oregon Lottery Graduate Scholarship. Funds for this scholarship are provided through the Oregon State Lottery and will be awarded to domestic or international graduate students enrolled in an advanced degree program at Oregon State University. These scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic merit and financial need.

2. Does the nominee intend to enroll in at least 9 credits each term during the 2021-2022 academic year?

6. Nominee degree type
7. Nominee college
8. Nominee program
9. Nominee OSU email
10. Submitter first name
11. Submitter last name
12. Submitter OSU email
13. Submitter title/position at OSU
14. Award contact first name (this person will be notified of any award decisions)
15. Award contact last name
16. Award contact OSU email
17. **Nomination Materials** – Nominators will be required to prepare the following materials as **one PDF document** and upload it to the nomination form:
 - a. A statement from the nominee that speaks to the following areas:
 - i. Their academic excellence and intellectual vitality demonstrated in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, their commitment and persistence related to previous academic pursuits, their intellectual curiosity and commitment, and the strengths and skills they bring to their graduate studies.
 - ii. A discussion of their personal strengths, skills, and previous experiences and how those contribute/will contribute to the creation of an inclusive and diverse university.
 - iii. How this award will support them in their graduate studies.
 - b. A nominating letter from the nominee's major professor or unit chair/head addressing the following:
 - i. The nominee's academic excellence and intellectual vitality demonstrated in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, the student's commitment and persistence related to previous academic pursuits, their intellectual curiosity, and the strengths and skills they bring to their graduate studies.
 - ii. An explanation as to how the award will support the nominee's graduate studies
 - c. A copy of the nominee's résumé or curriculum vitae
