

POSTDOCTORAL FELLOW IN BIOLOGICAL OCEANOGRAPHY

Two-year postdoctoral fellow position available beginning October 2023 to work on ongoing projects on predator-prey dynamics and size spectra in the plankton. We use high-resolution *in situ* imagery combined with targeted net sampling to identify the biological and physical processes driving fine-scale plankton distributions.

The successful applicant will have a PhD in biological oceanography or a related field, oceanographic field experience, and experience working with large datasets. We are looking for someone with exceptional quantitative and biostatistics skills, and familiarity with data management. Strong writing skills are also important.

Applicants should be highly motivated, organized, and able to work both independently as well as within a team. This postdoctoral fellow position is based in the Plankton Ecology Laboratory (Drs. Su Sponaugle & Robert Cowen; http://hmsc.oregonstate.edu/research-labs/planktonlab) at Oregon State University's Hatfield Marine Science Center in Newport, Oregon.
